

GOLF SE JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2018 -

EVENTS AND CONDITIONS

EVENT 1.

Golf SE Junior Boys and Girls Championship

18 Hole stroke event. For all junior boys and girls who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with GOLF South East Inc, have a GA Handicap and are under the age of 18 years on the day of competition.

EVENT 2.

Golf SE Junior Boys and Girls Open

18 Hole handicap event. Open to all junior boys and girls who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with GOLF SA or State or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognized by this Association who are under the age of 18 years on the day of competition.

EVENTS 3 & 4

Golf SE Sub Junior Boys and Girls Championship

9 and 6 hole stroke events played on a short course with modified rules. Open to all junior boys and girls who do not have a GA Handicap and are under the age of 18 years on the day of competition.

CONDITIONS

Ties: In the event of a tie for first place in Event 1, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, players will continue play over such holes as the Match Committee will decide, in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole playoff until the winner is determined. Ties for other place getters and all other events will be decided by countback.

The Match Committee: will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions. The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final. Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play.

The Entrance Fee for the event is \$10.00 (including GST), and must be paid on the day of the event. No charge for SE Futures members. Entries close on 1st November 2018 and the draw will be posted on the Golf SE website on Friday before the competition. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee

Caddies are not permitted for players in Events 1 & 2.

Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence from the player's Club and by permission of the venue Club. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

Spectators are welcome on the course providing they maintain a distance of at least 20 metres from the players

and refrain from talking to or coaching the players. Occasional words of encouragement and support are always acceptable.

R & A Rules of Golf and Local Rules shall apply.

Smoking Players and caddies are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round

Mobile Phones Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.

Measuring Devices A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

Prizes it is Golf SE policy that players may only win one major prize. Presentation of prizes will be made as soon after the last group have finished play. All players are expected to stay for the presentations.
